- Supervision of co-curricular activities outside the classroom, which may include sports teams, community service activities, clubs, or school publications
- Serving as an academic advisor to a group of students
- Participation in school-wide and faculty events and gatherings
- Involvement in relevant task forces to enhance our educational environment
